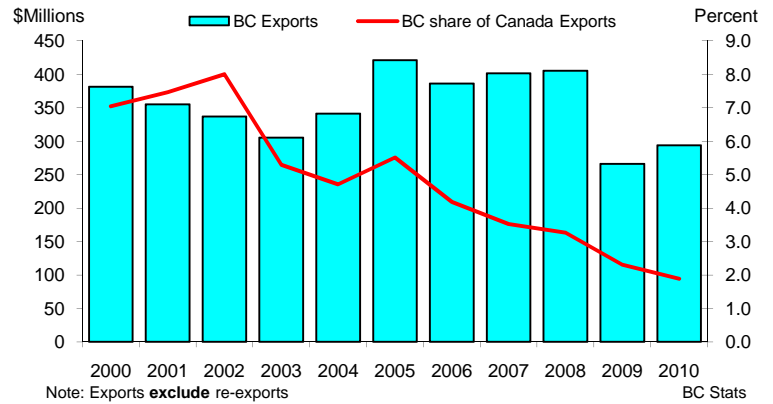

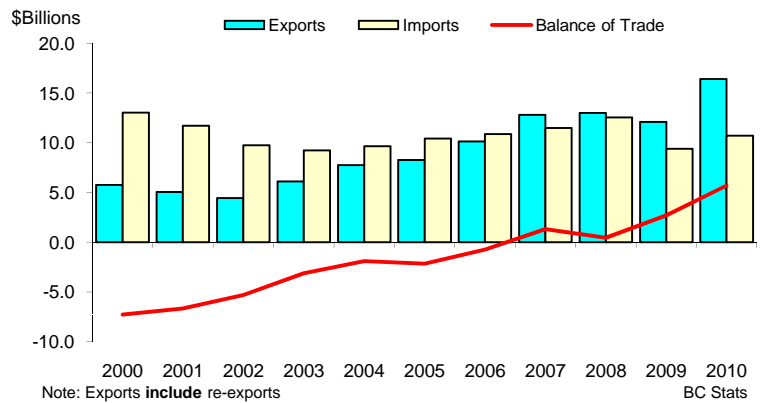
## BC Origin Exports to United Kingdom

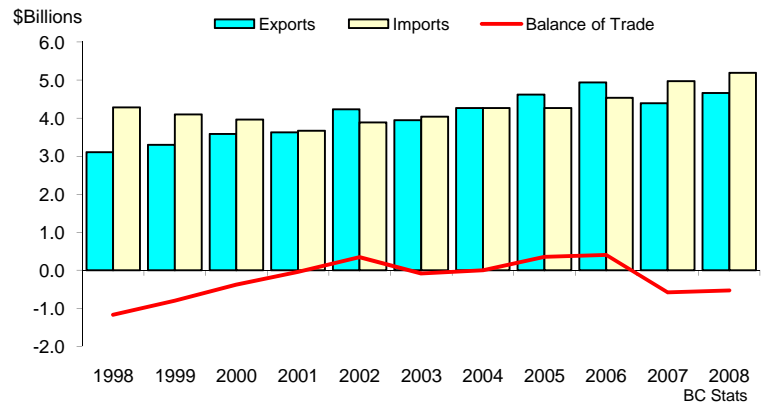
## Canada's Balance of Trade in Goods with United Kingdom

### How important is United Kingdom to BC and Canada?

United Kingdom ranked #10 as a destination for BC origin exports in 2010 with 1.0% of BC's commodity exports shipped there. It was ranked #2 as a destination for Canadian exports with 4.2% of Canadian goods exports shipped there and #6 as a source of imports into Canada with 2.7% of Canadian imports originating from United Kingdom.

### How important is Canada to United Kingdom?

Canada was the source of approximately 2.4% of imports into United Kingdom in 2009. Approximately 3.3% of exports from United Kingdom were destined for Canada in that year.

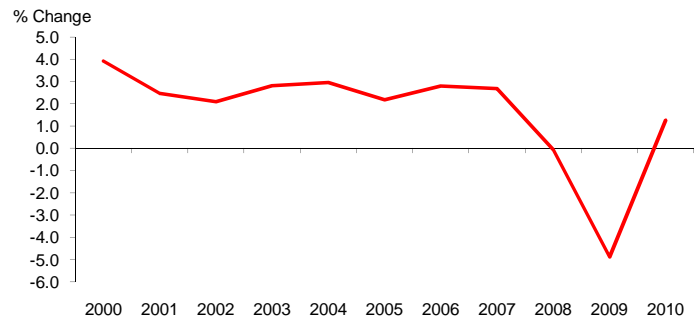

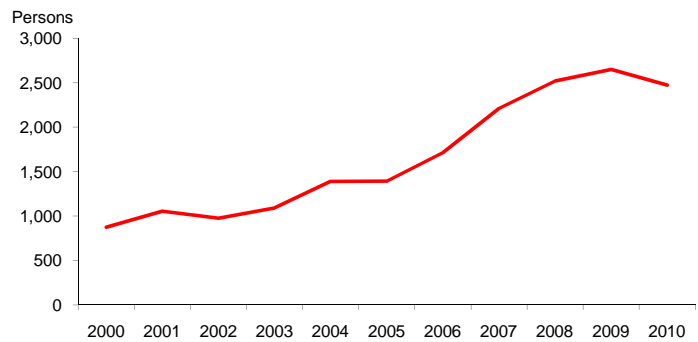
## Year-Over-Year % Growth in GDP of United Kingdom

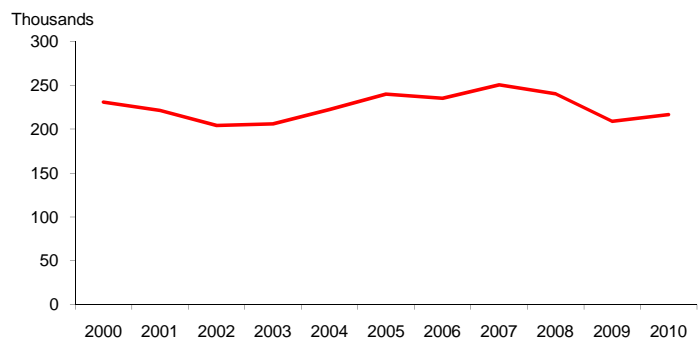
## Immigrants to BC from United Kingdom
