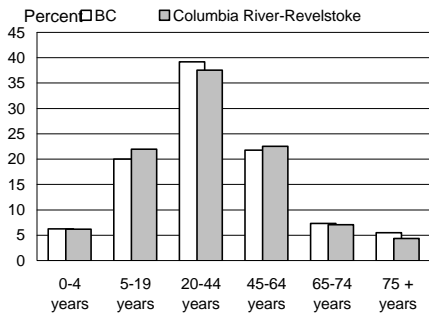

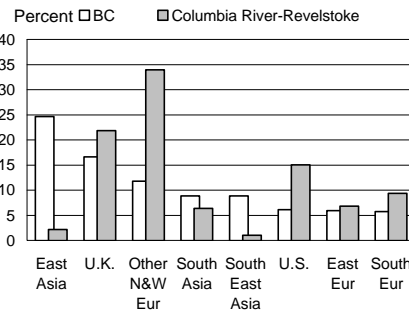

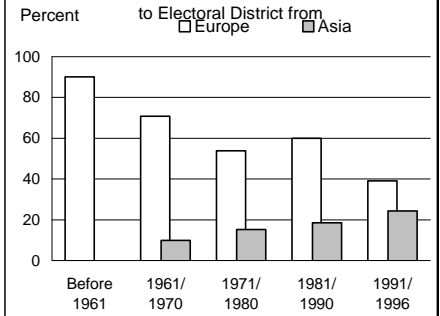
Birthplace of Immigrant Population

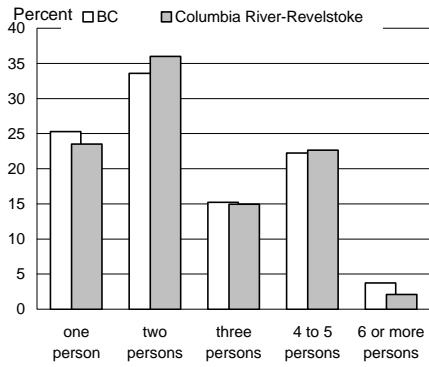
Percent of Immigrants from Europe and Asia

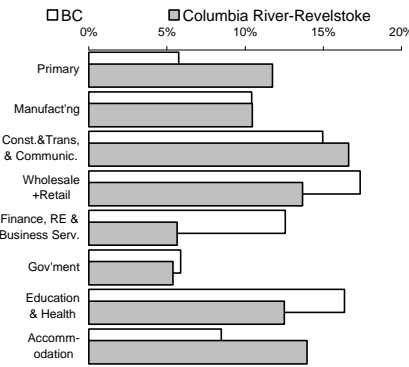
Households by Size

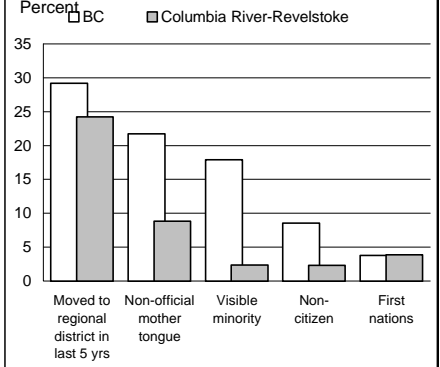
Labour Force by Industry

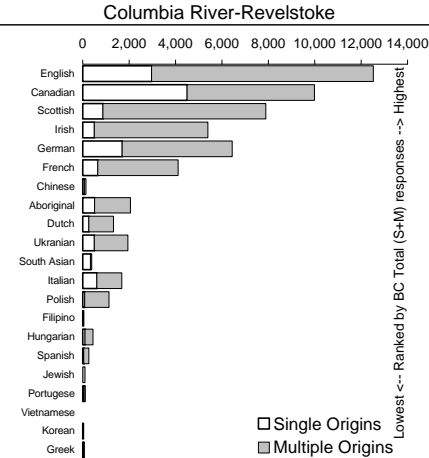

**Ethnicity**

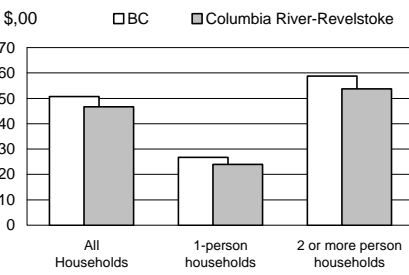
Single and Multiple Ethnic Origins in Columbia River-Revelstoke
