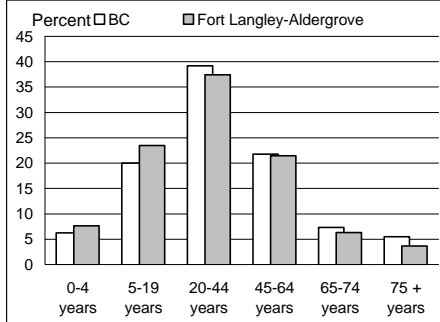

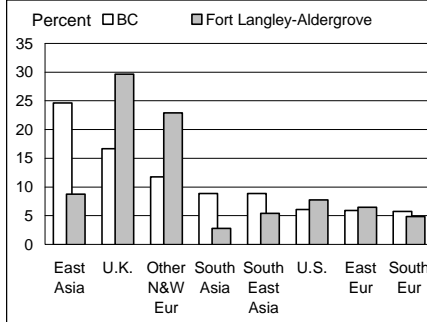
Population by Age Group

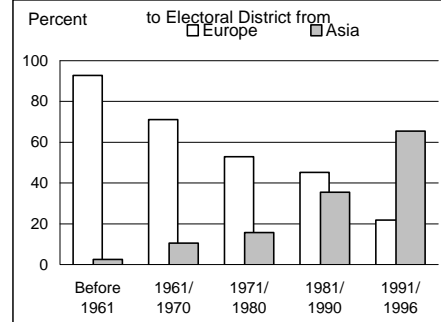
Birthplace of Immigrant Population

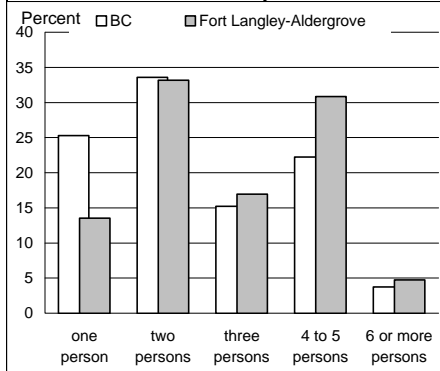
Percent of Immigrants from Europe and Asia

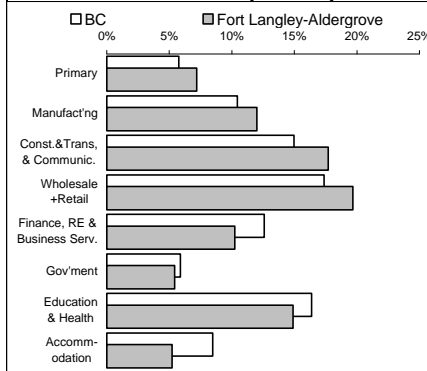

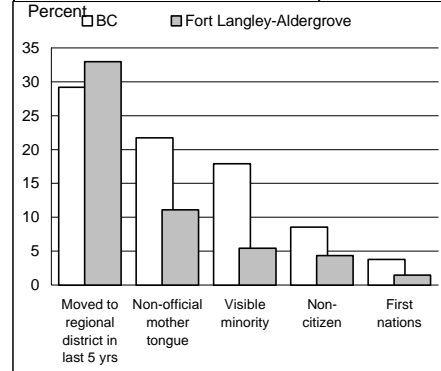
Labour Force by Industry



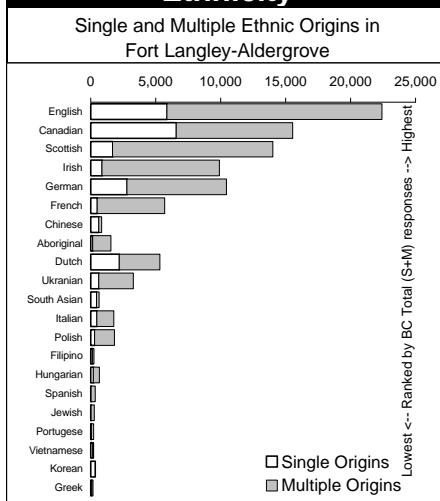

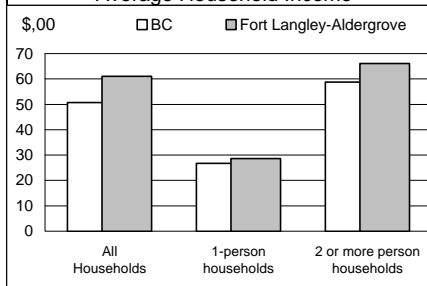
