

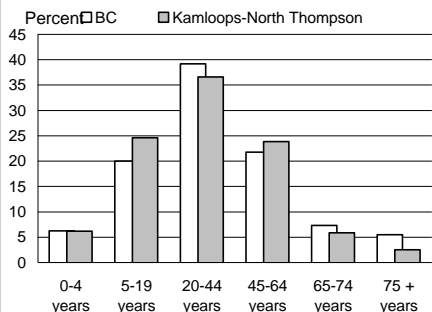

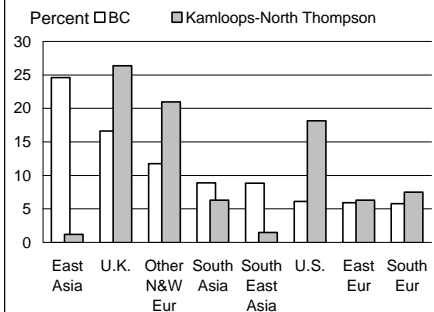

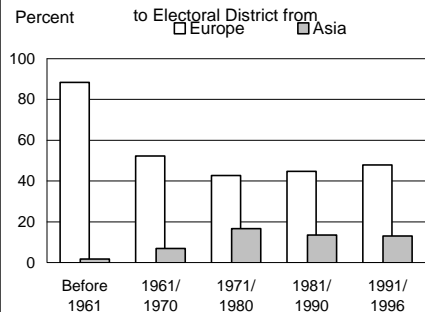
Birthplace of Immigrant Population

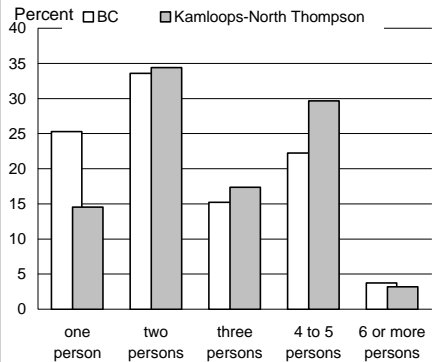
Percent of Immigrants from Europe and Asia

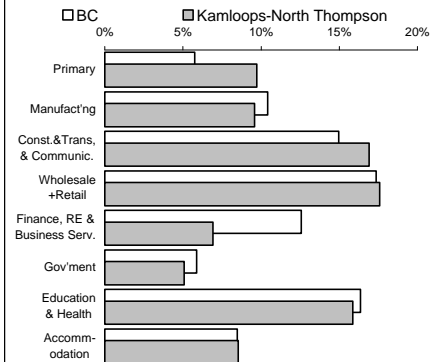
Households by Size

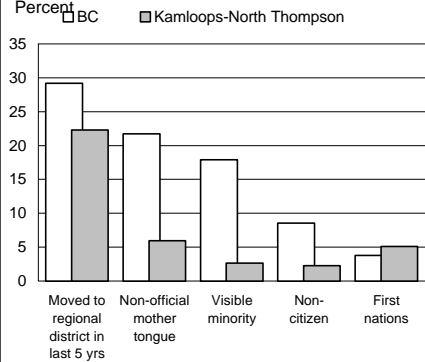
Labour Force by Industry

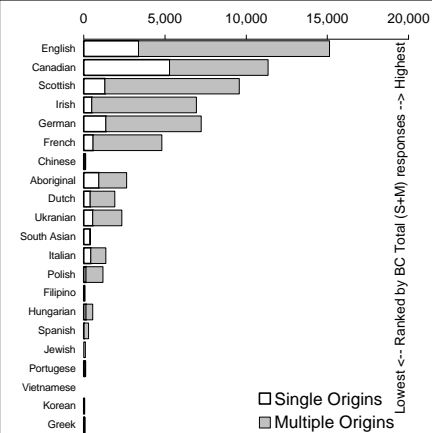

Ethnicity

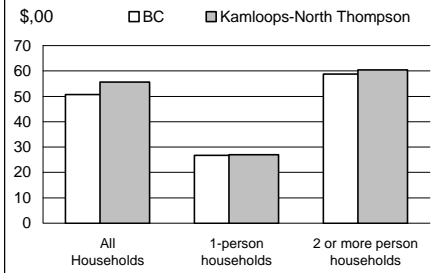
Single and Multiple Ethnic Origins in Kamloops-North Thompson
