

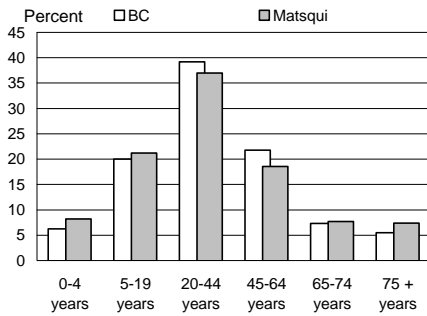

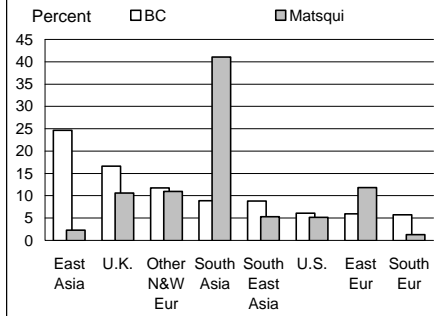

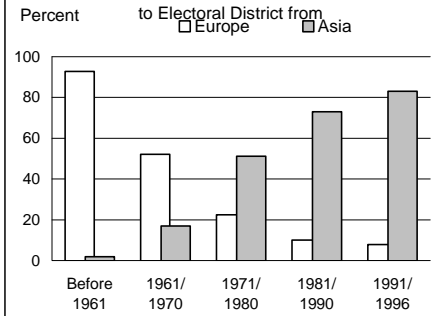
Birthplace of Immigrant Population

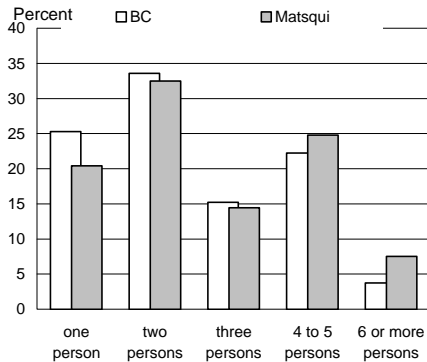
Percent of Immigrants from Europe and Asia

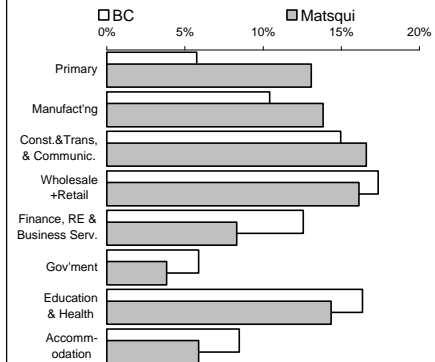

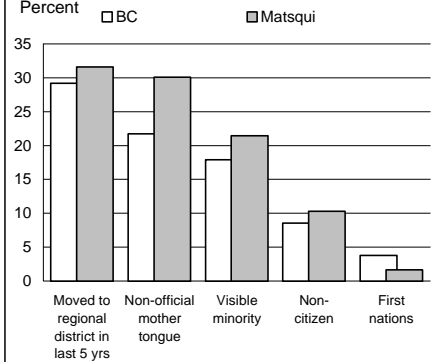
Labour Force by Industry

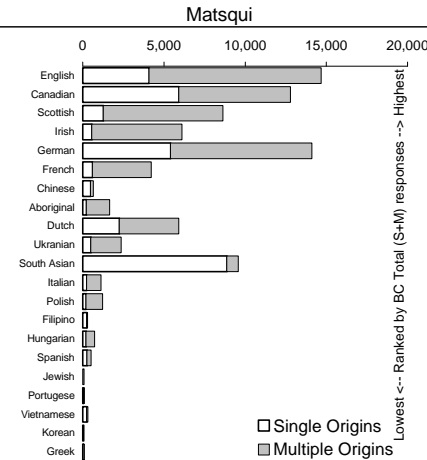

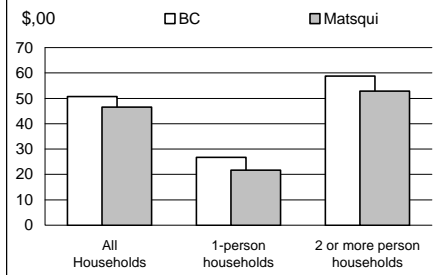
Single and Multiple Ethnic Origins in Matsqui

is suppressed and data for all others is randomly rounded to preserve privacy of individuals, PED figures here will not match data published elsewhere that have been rounded after first aggregating unsuppressed and unrounded FED EA data.
