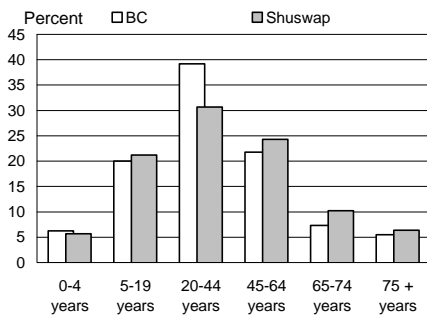

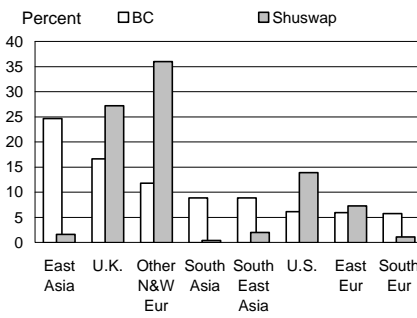
### Population by Age Group

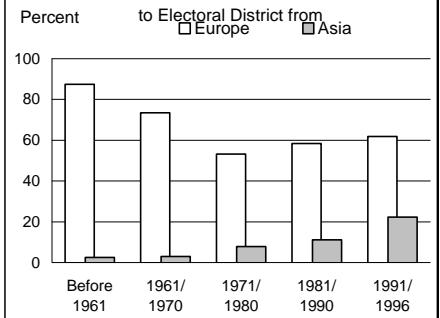
### Birthplace of Immigrant Population

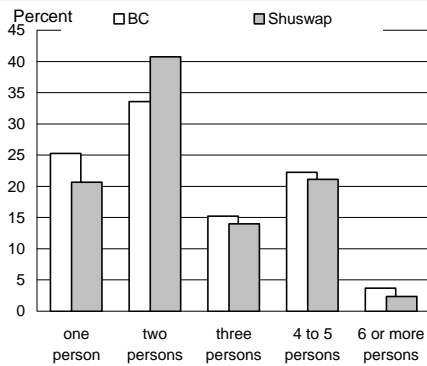
### Percent of Immigrants from Europe and Asia

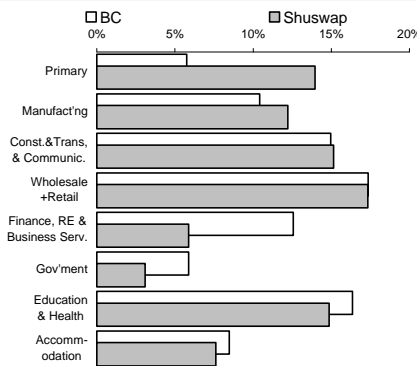
### Households by Size

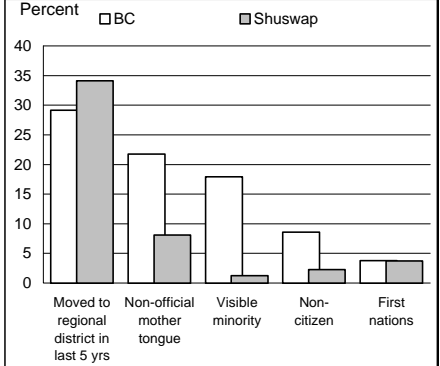
### Labour Force by Industry

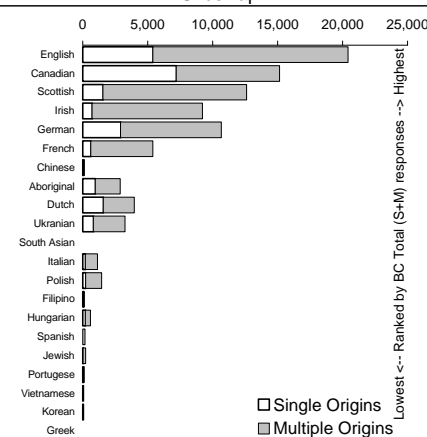

## Ethnicity

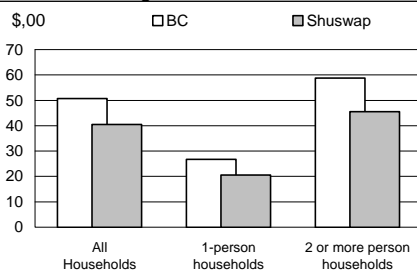
### Single and Multiple Ethnic Origins in Shuswap
