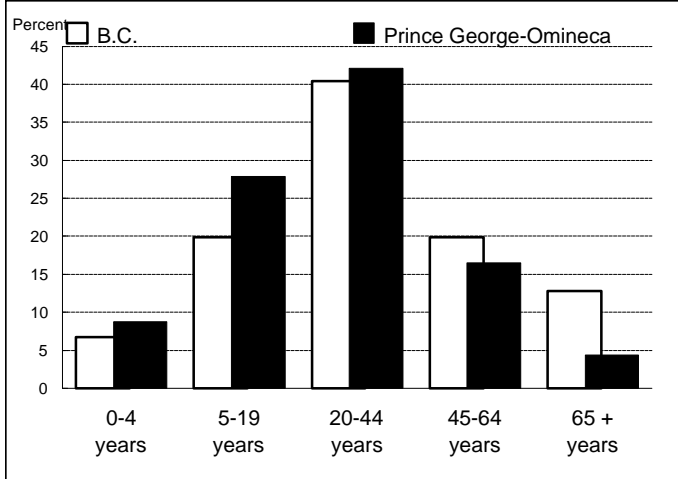

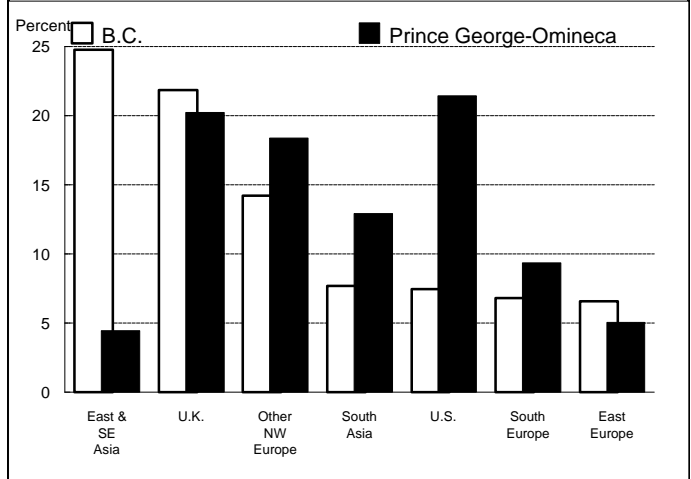

Percent Distribution by Age Group



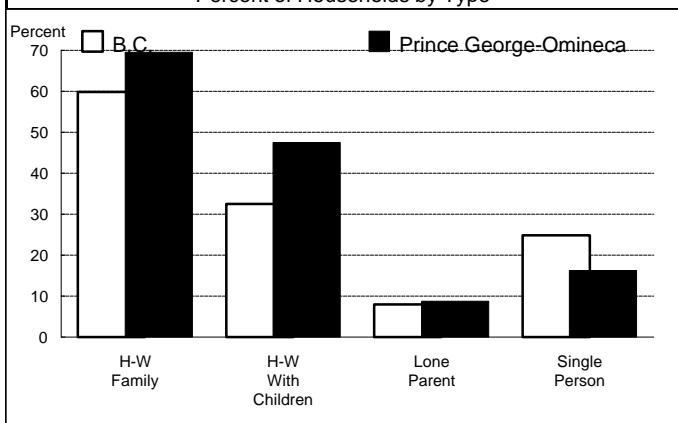
