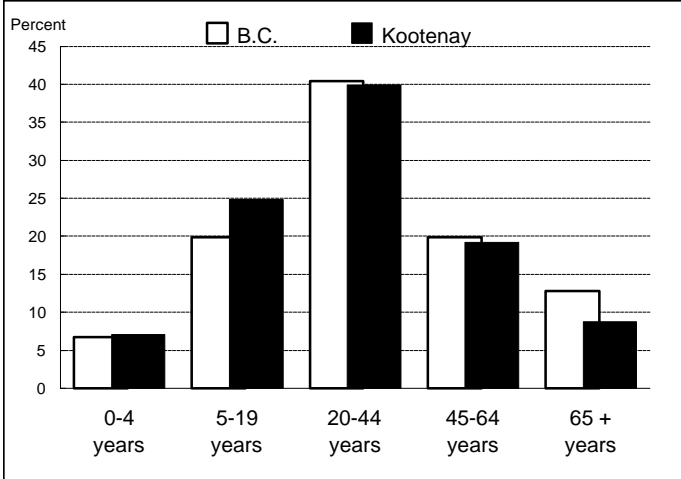

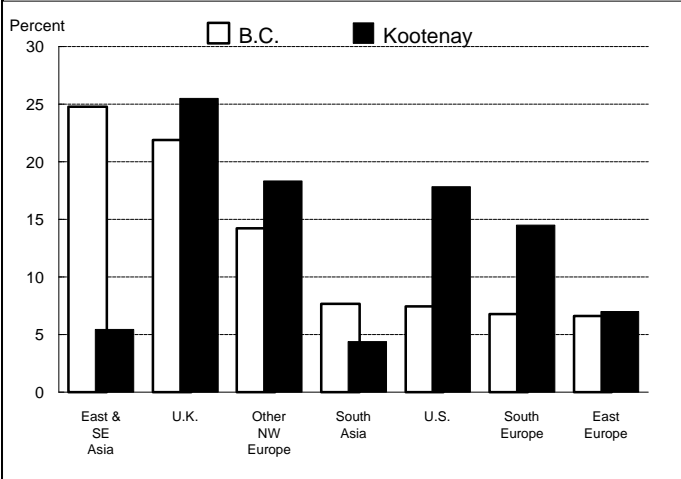

Percent Distribution by Age Group



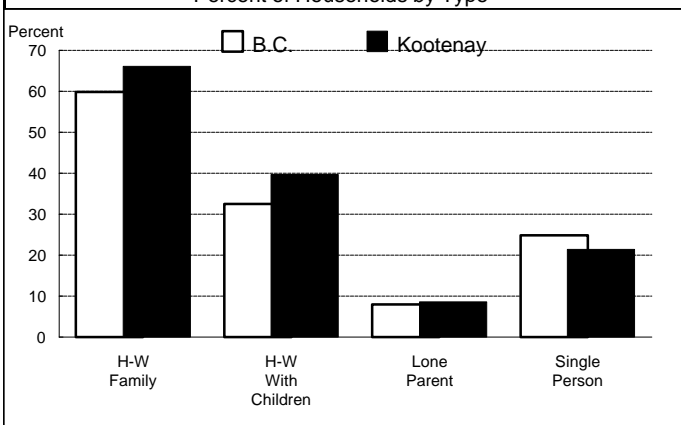
Distribution of Immigrant Population (in B.C. share order)
