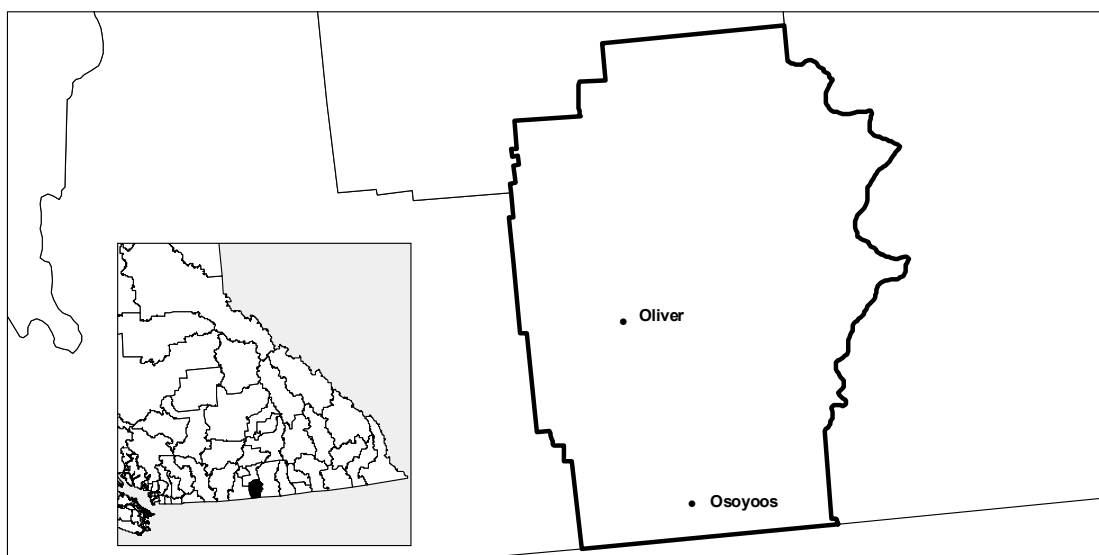

POPULATION EXTRAPOLATION FOR ORGANIZATIONAL PLANNING WITH LESS ERROR

British Columbia small area population projections result from the application of a "Component/Cohort-Survival" population model to area-specific assumptions dealing with fertility, mortality and migration. The Component/Cohort-Survival method requires separate forecasts of each of the components of population change, namely fertility, mortality and migration. With this information, and with a base year age-specific estimate of population, a projection for any subsequent year is made by promoting each age group in the preceding year to the next highest age group, while at the same time taking into account the effects of net migration, deaths and births. In general, all assumptions relating to migration, births and deaths by small area are based on past conditions, modified wherever possible to take into consideration possible future changes. Consequently, the resulting population projections are not necessarily what will be, but rather what could be, given the realization of these conditions. It is certainly possible that unforeseen changes in factors such as economic development, government policy, land use and zoning will affect future populations. Consequently, the projections should only be regarded as one possible scenario of the future size and age-sex structure of the population.

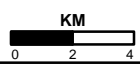

GENERAL ECONOMY

Like much of the Okanagan region, this area is highly dependent on agriculture and tourism. There is also a base of retired people living in the area. The warm and pleasant climate helps draw tourists and retirees to the area and the service sector relating to these two groups is an economic driver. The climate also makes the region perfectly suited to growing tree fruits, wine grapes and vegetables. Cattle ranching is also an important activity in the agricultural sector.

DEMOGRAPHICS

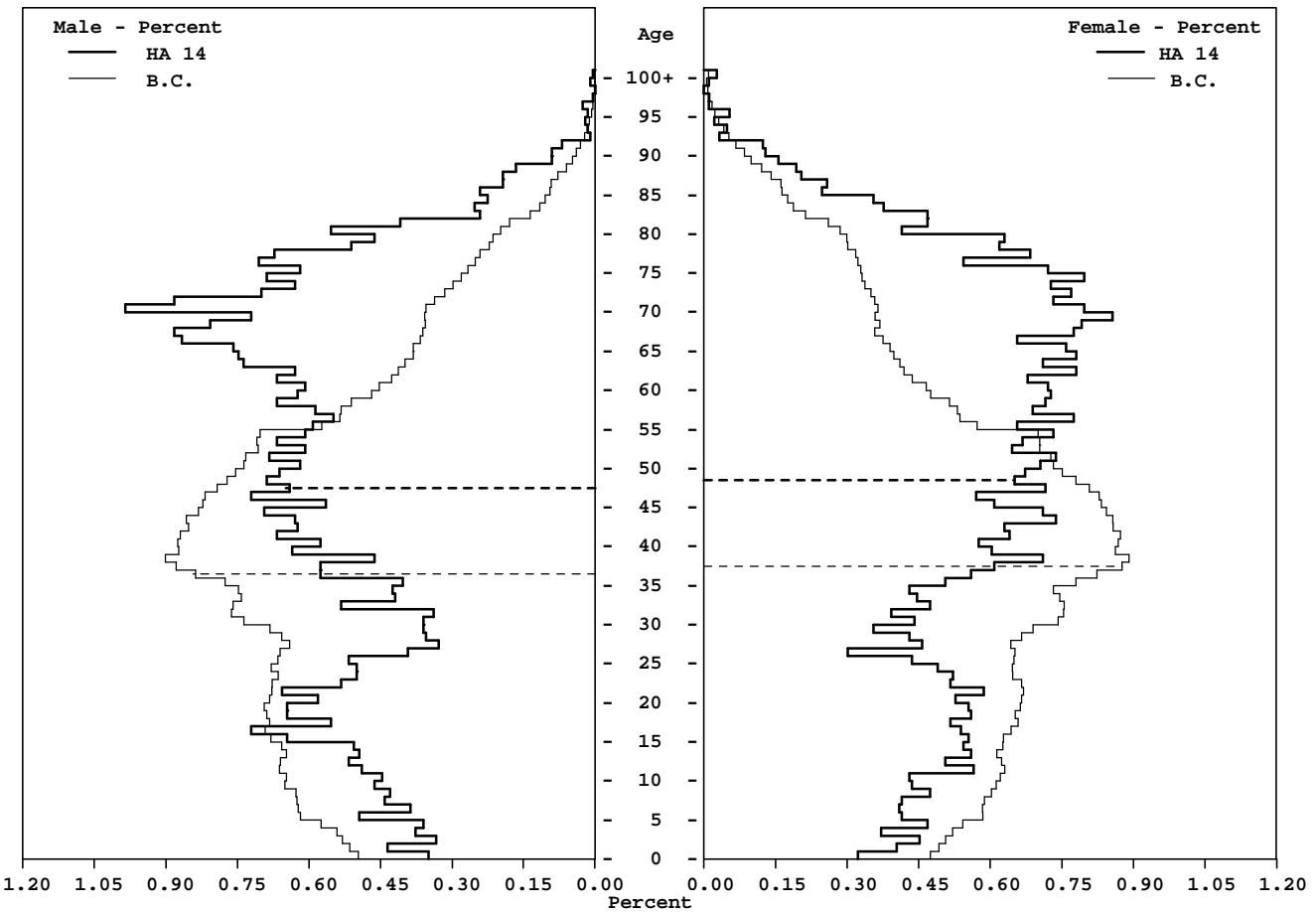
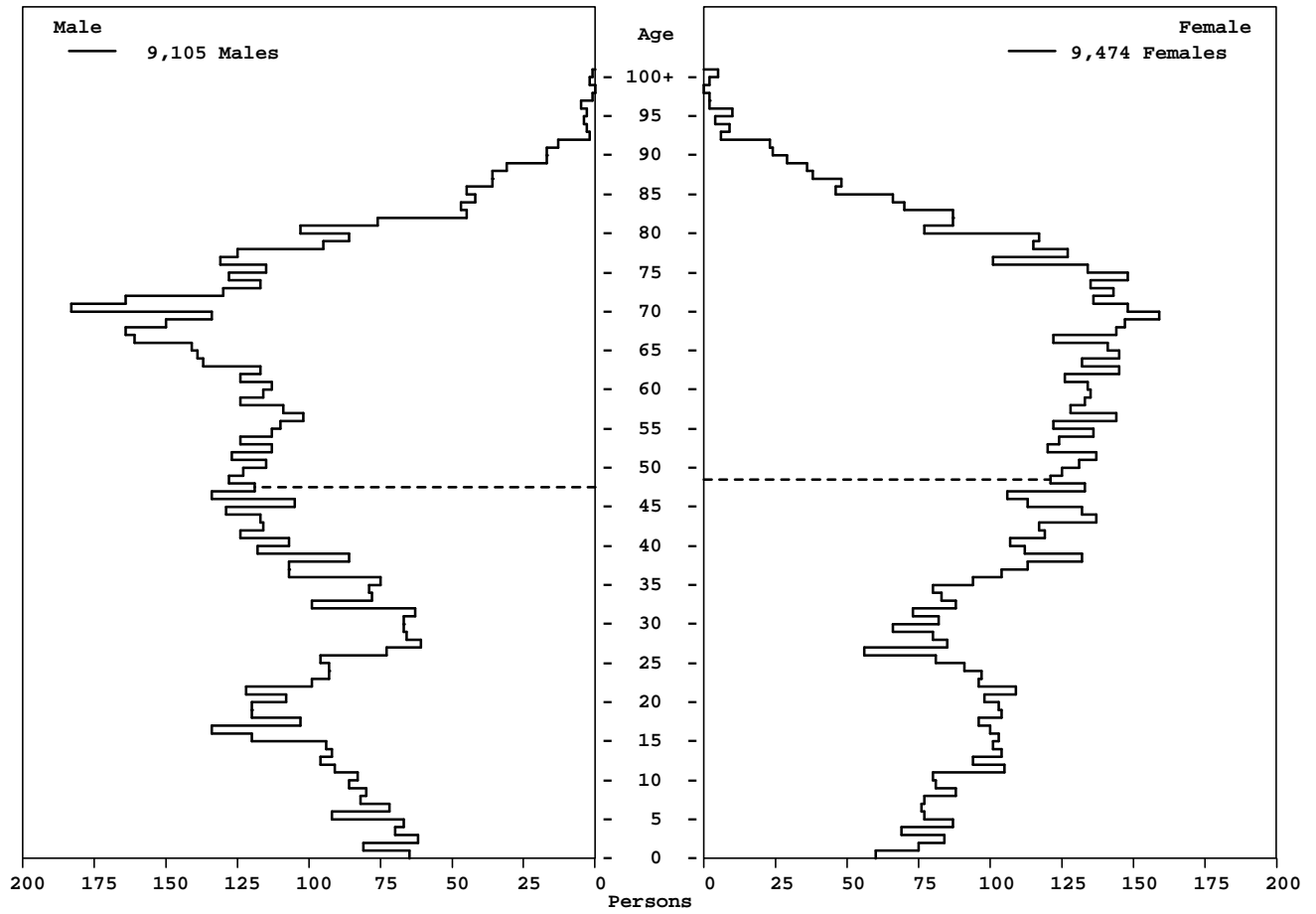
Other than a brief period in the mid-eighties, this area has generally experienced positive net inflows of migrants. Population growth in this area has been much higher than the provincial average during the early nineties, slowing over the last several years to less than the average provincial growth.

The median age of the residents of this area is substantially higher than the provincial median age. This is due to the large base of retired people that have settled in the region. Other demographic differences that are a direct result of this abundance of retirees are a higher percentage of females (since women tend to live longer than men), and a substantially higher elderly dependency ratio (i.e., the proportion of people aged 65 and over compared to the working age population of those aged 18 to 64).

PROJECTIONS

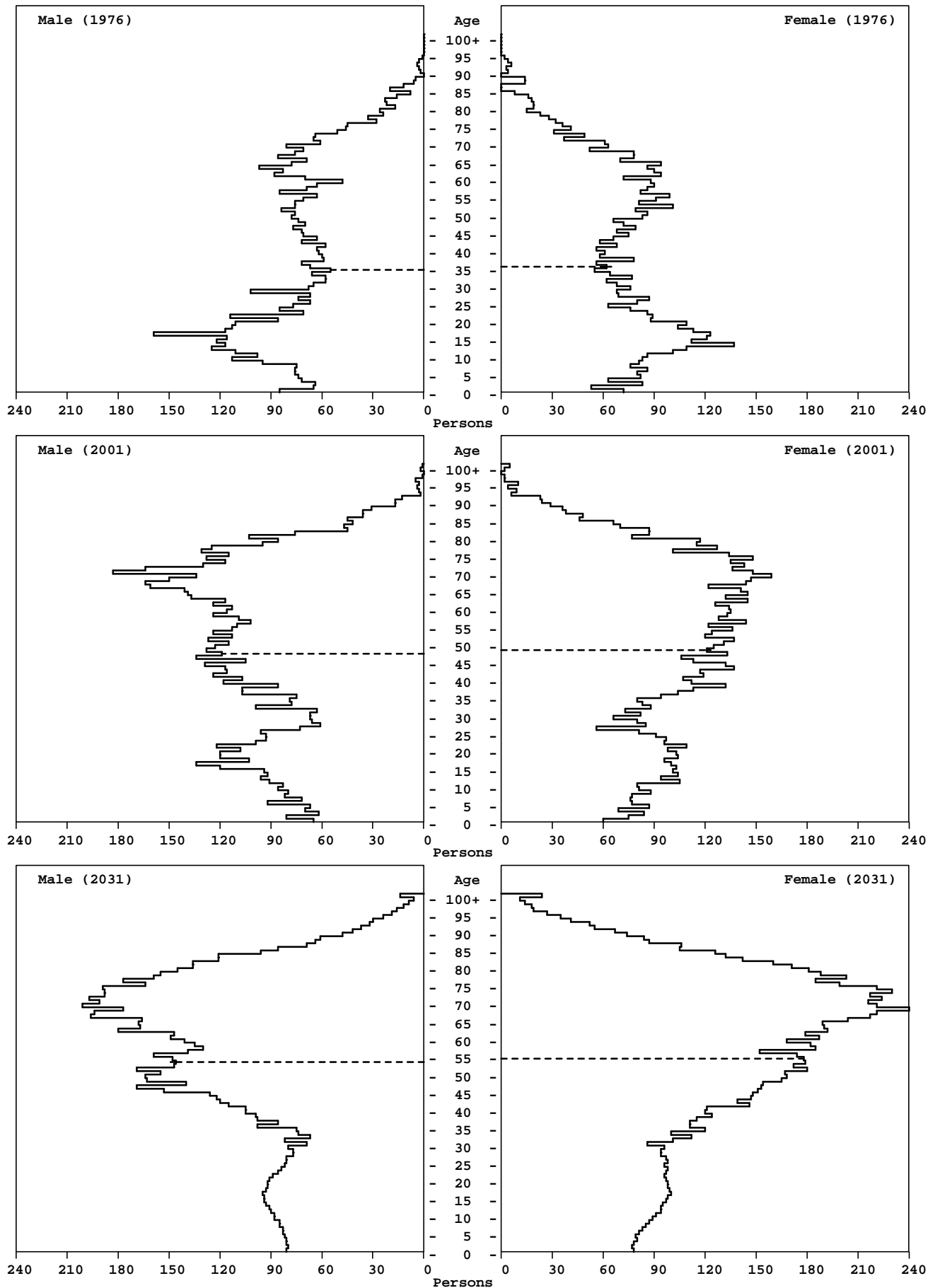
The stability of the agricultural sector and retirement-related services should ensure stable growth for this region. This area will likely continue to receive strong inflows of migrants, although as time goes on, it will lose an increasing number of people due to a negative rate of natural increase (i.e., the number of deaths will exceed the number of births). However, growth will remain slightly positive.

Population Age Distribution - 2001 Local Health Area 14: Southern Okanagan



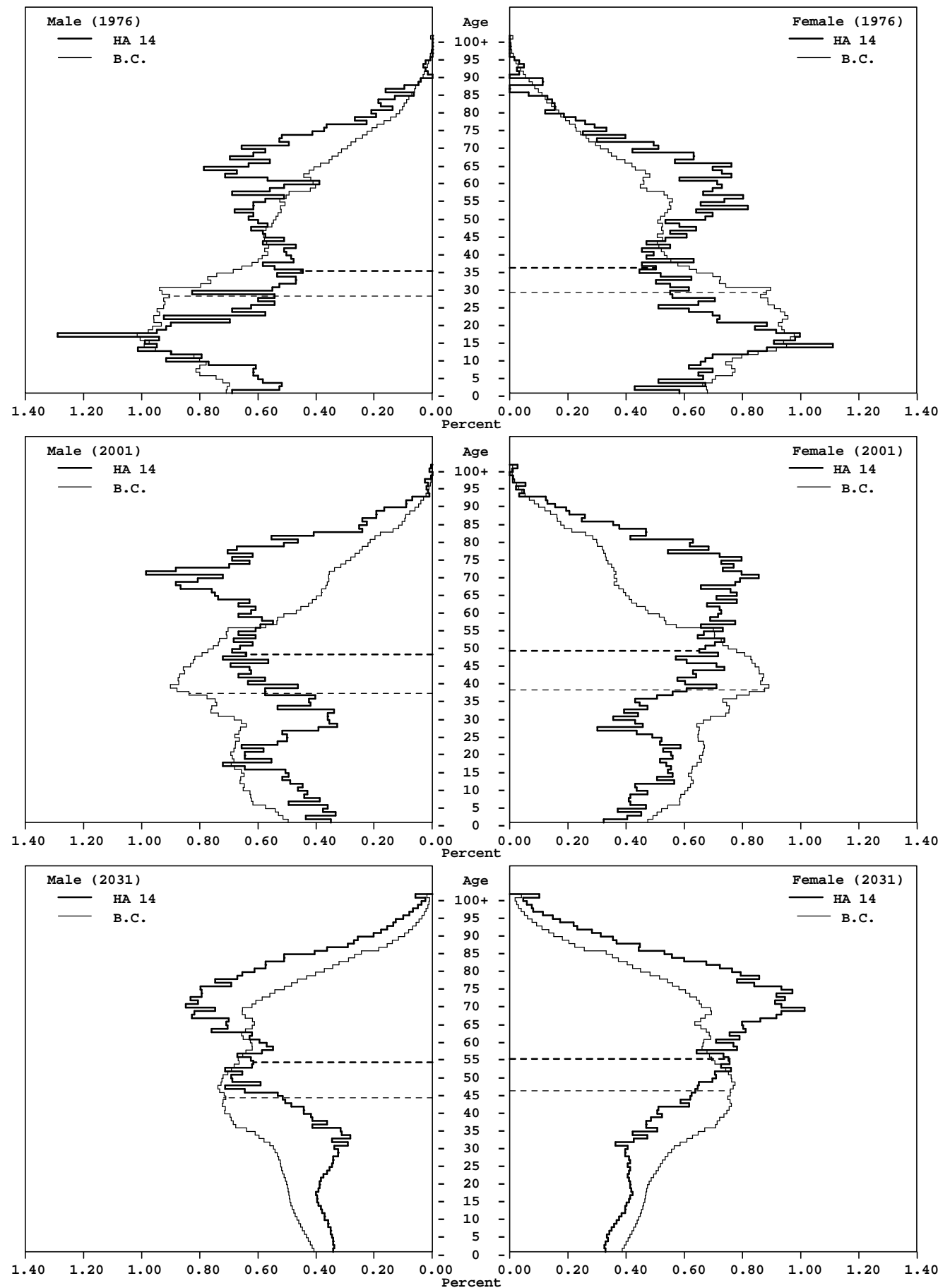

Population Age Distribution - 1976 2001 2031 Local Health Area 14: Southern Okanagan



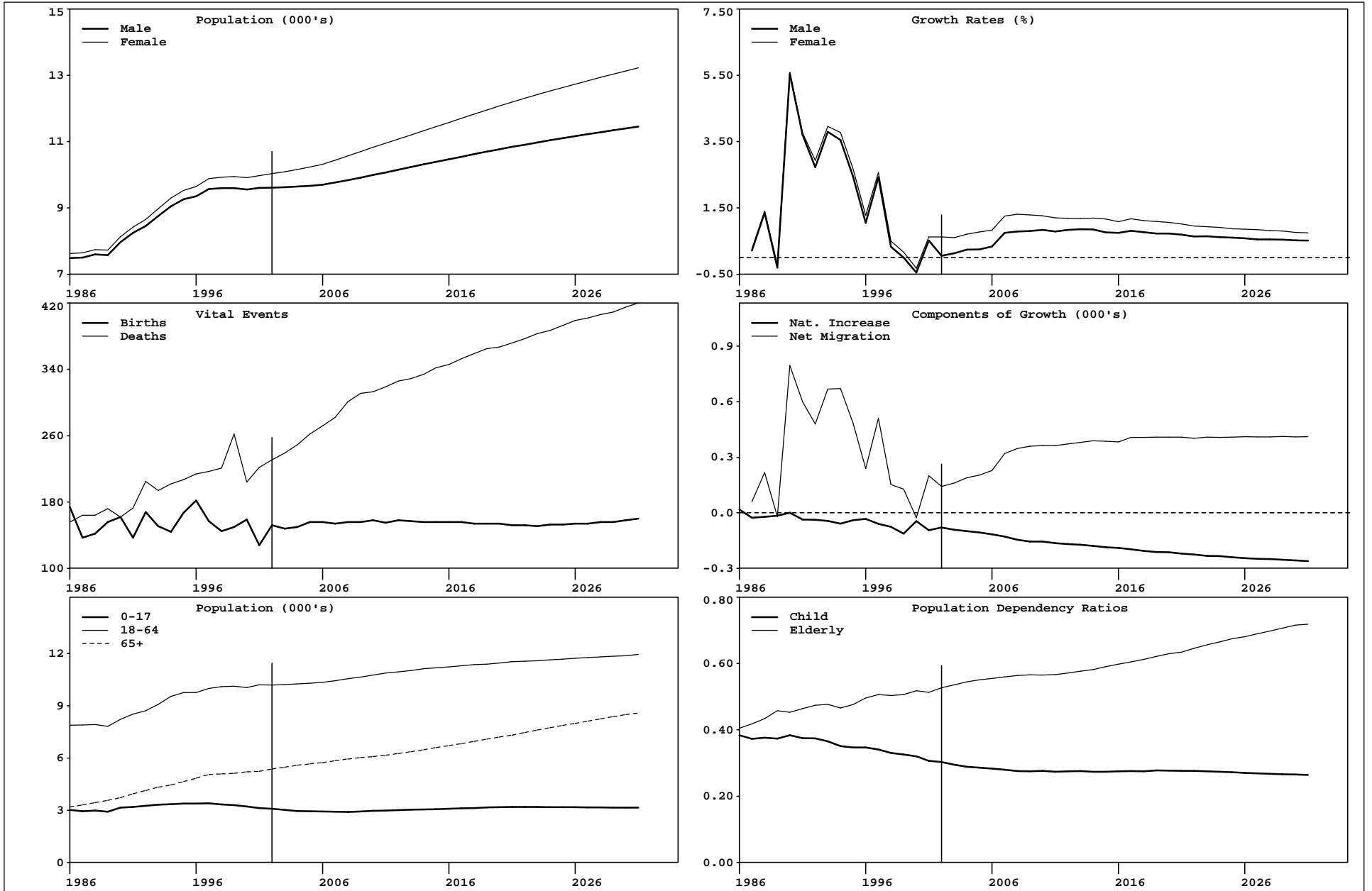
