Census Profile (Every 5 Years)

There are a range of similar products for different Censuses and geographies. Graphic presentation, some with tables. Mix of public and free subscription access. See www.bcstats.gov.bc.ca/census.asp

Regional and Community Facts (Semi-Annual)

A three- page compendium of statistics including: population; selected Census characteristics (2001 and 2006); residential property assessment summary; building permits; personal taxation; BC Benefits recipients; E.I. beneficiaries; incorporations; and bankruptcies. Annual data, two pages per region or community. On our Web site for free access. Updated two times a year.

Community Profiles (Always Current)

A series of looseleaf binders, each devoted to one of 28 regional districts, featuring the broadest range of regional data. Some maps and charts. 200+ to 400+ pages per regional district with most data provided for all communities in each region. Annual data maintained so that purchaser gets latest available information.

Socio-Economic Statistical Profiles AND Indices (Annual)

A single looseleaf binder, organized by region and providing socio-economic information such as age, ethnic origin, migration, social assistance recipients, crime, education, child care, health, income and labour market activity. Maps, charts and tables. Complete data tables provided in the appendix. Regional Districts and Local Health Areas. Updated annually. Latest edition: 2005. Free on our Web site.

Quarterly Regional Statistics (Quarterly)

A single release, organized by region, featuring current monthly and quarterly economic data to provide an up to date measurement of local activity compared to that of the province. Text, charts and tables. Approximately 240 pages. Released quarterly. Available free BC Stats site at www.bcstats.gov.bc.ca.

Regional Index (Suspended) (now an Internet-only publication, free at www.regionalindex.gov.bc.ca)

A comprehensive, narrative and statistical examination of the geographic, economic and social structure of B.C.'s eight development regions and incorporated Census Subdivisions. Free on the Web.

BC and sub-provincial Population Projection (Annual)

Health Regions, Regional Districts and Development Regions, School Districts and College Regions

This 25-year forecast projects the composition of the population in each area. Detailed statistical tables provide historical and forecast population by age and sex, including components of change. Summary output, with no age and sex breakout, is available free to browse or download (CSV format) on our site at www.bcstats.gov.bc.ca/data/pop/pop/popproj.asp. Full detail, including age and sex, available in WebStore at www.bcstats.gov.bc.ca. Updated annually. **NEW! Population Pyramid builder on our site.**

Manufacturers' Directory (Annual)

Lists B.C. manufacturers by company name (detailed listing), industry, product, and regional district by community. This publication details 4,700 manufacturers including employment size, commodities produced, export status and a contact name and address. Available in print, as a CSV file on diskette, or searchable free Web-enabled version at www.made-in-bc.ca.

Major Projects Inventory (Quarterly)

Information on major capital projects, listed by development region and status (proposed, under construction, on hold or completed). Includes brief regional profiles and maps. Updated quarterly. Free.

Tourism Sector Monitor (formerly *Tourism Room Revenue*) (Monthly)

A monthly release, available by subscription, with estimates of revenues received from room rental by type of accommodation, with a geographic breakdown by development region, regional district and selected urban areas. Seasonally adjusted estimates are provided for development region totals and for accommodation type totals. Approximately 16 pages per month. Available free on BC Stats web site.
